- ❖ As per Rule 3.4 of Rules & Regulations of NECC, poultry farmers with bird strength of 250 layers and above, and egg traders who handled a minimum of 12,000 eggs per day, shall be eligible to become ordinary members on payment of requisite fee. Firms/ companies can be registered in their respective names with proper authorisation to only one person in writing representing the firm/ company.
- ❖ This form should be supported with purchase bill for a minimum of 250 day-old layer chicks during the previous 12 months or if the applicant is a trader, he should produce proper evidence for having traded in 12,000 or more eggs per day together with a copy of the bank statement in his own/firm name, during the previous three months.
